How Drugs Are Classified In The U.S.

Classification	Examples	Description
Schedule I	Marijuana - LSD - Ecstasy (MDMA) - Heroin	Schedule I drugs are classified as substances that have a high potential for abuse and no accepted medical use and are not safe to use under medical supervision.
Schedule II	Cocaine Lorazepam Morphine Oxycodone Propofol Valium	Schedule II drugs are classified as substances that have a high potential for abuse and have a limited medical use. Abuse of these drugs can result in severe psychological or physical dependence.
Schedule III	Low-dose morphine Alprazolam Codeine Fentanyl Hydrocodone	Schedule III drugs are classified as substances that have a high potential for abuse and have a limited medical use. Abuse of these drugs can result in moderate to severe psychological or physical dependence.
Schedule IV	Alprazolam Xanax Soma Risperidone Zolpidem	Schedule IV drugs are classified as substances that have a lower potential for abuse than Schedule II and III and have a limited medical use. Abuse of these drugs can result in moderate psychological or physical dependence.
Schedule V	Codeine Syrup (less than 200 mg) Lyrica Morphine Lyrica Promethazine	Schedule V drugs are classified as substances with the lowest potential for abuse and have a limited medical use in the U.S. with limited potential for psychological or physical dependence.

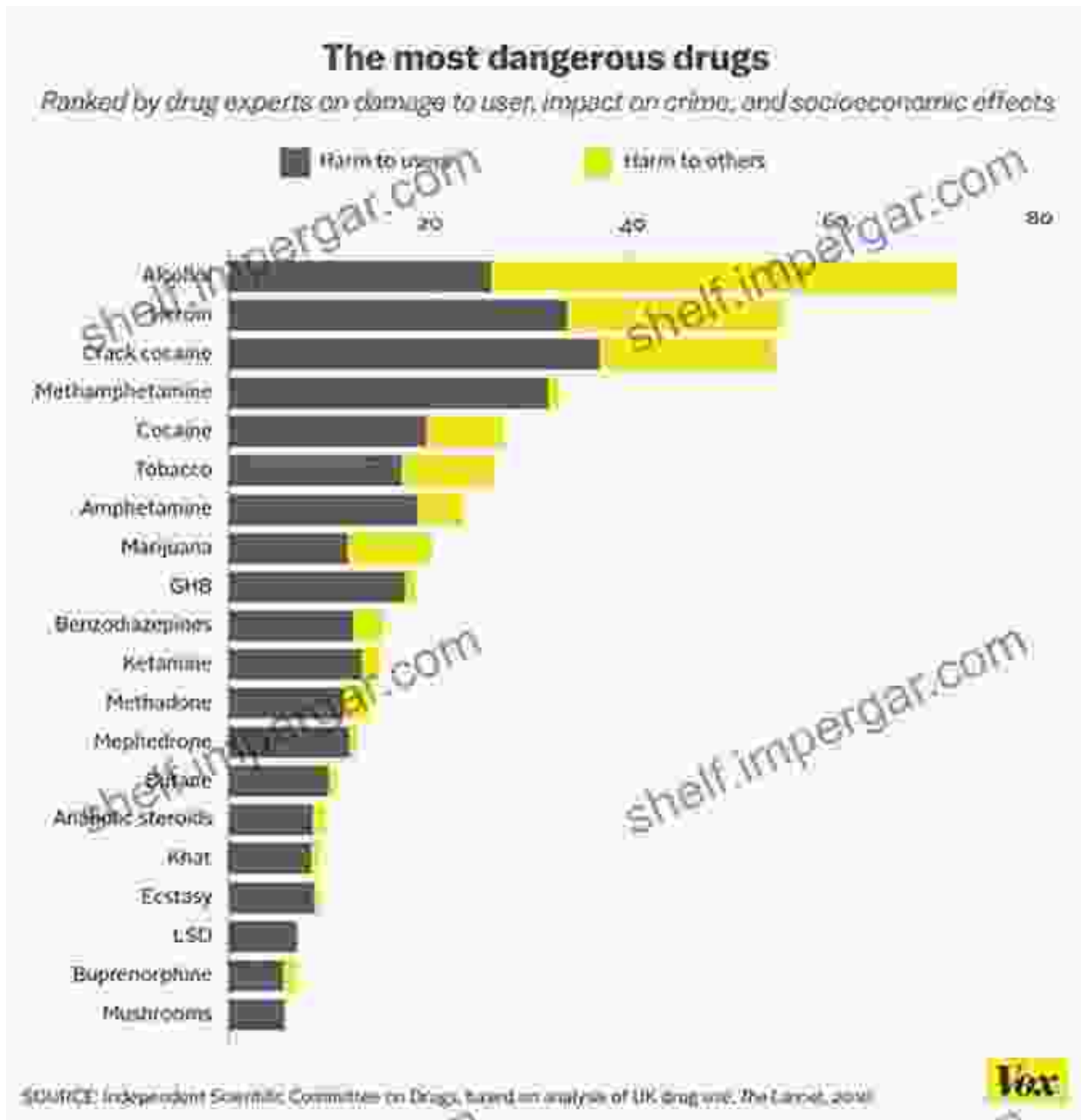

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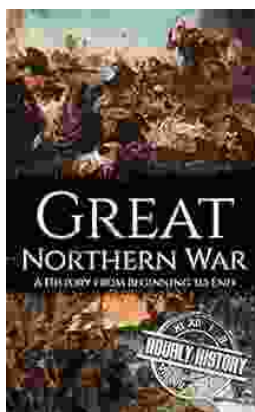
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
