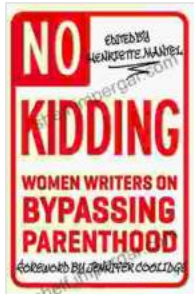

parenthood. However, they are all united by their passion for writing and their desire to share their stories with others.

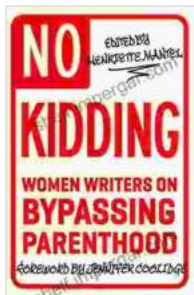
Here are just a few of the contributors to No Kidding:
