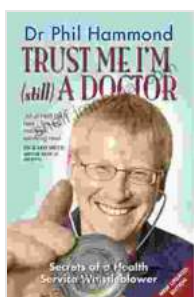

Today, I am sober and clean. I have a job, a home, and a family. I am grateful for every day that I am sober. I know that I could not have done it without the help of others.

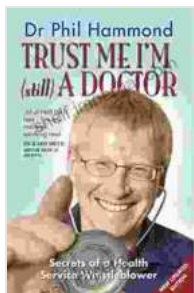

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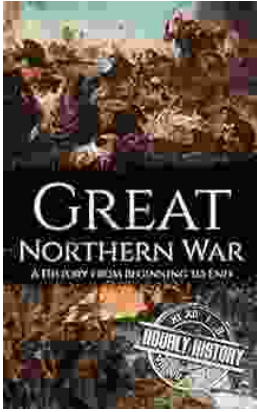
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
